



## Change to the list of Statements of Principles, June 2022

11 minor amendment Statements of Principals have come into force on 8 April 2022.

These Statements of Principles cover:

- diabetes mellitus
- hypogonadism
- hypopituitarism
- sensorineural hearing loss
- immune thrombocytopaenia
- acute lymphoblastic leukaemia/lymphoblastic lymphoma.
